
Biodiversity and landscape enhancements



A range of biodiversity and landscape enhancements would be included as part of the Proposed Development. These include:

- New and reinforced native hedgerow planted along field boundaries and within the the site itself, connecting existing retained hedgerows. This would primarily provide visual screening, but also improve on-site habitats and local biodiversity.
- Creation of conservation headlands with native woodland, scrub and species-rich grassland habitats, enhancing on-site biodiversity. These areas would be located around the margins of the site.
- Scattered native trees planted along the northern boundary of the site. These would help with visual containment and be integrated within the conservation headland and species-rich grassland areas.
